Control Burn Scheduled in Butte County

Project Name: Camelot

Location: 1985 Clark Road, Oroville, CA (Camelot Equestrian Park)

Project Size: 125 acres

Objective: To reduce hazardous fuels, enhance natural resources, and increase public safety in the Butte Valley community

Prescribed Fire Period: Planned for Monday, June 15, weather permitting

Project Description: CAL FIRE-Butte Unit and the Mechoopda Tribal Stewardship Crew will be undertaking the Camelot prescribed fire project on the property of the Camelot Equestrian Park. The project will employ prescribed fire alongside other vegetation management techniques to achieve its objectives.

Project Details: The Camelot Prescribed Fire aims to treat approximately 125 acres of land South of Durham-Pentz Hwy and north of the Camelot Equestrian Park. Weather conditions will be closely monitored, and the project will only commence when conditions are within the prescribed parameters. Part of CAL FIRE's commitment to its Vegetation Management Program, this project contributes to the goal of treating 100,000 acres annually in California.

Importance of Vegetation Management: Prescribed burns are essential for reducing fire fuels in areas of Butte County that are susceptible to fire and can lead to a larger campaign fires. The safety of the community and surrounding areas is our top priority. Residents are encouraged to stay informed about project updates and any related safety measures. 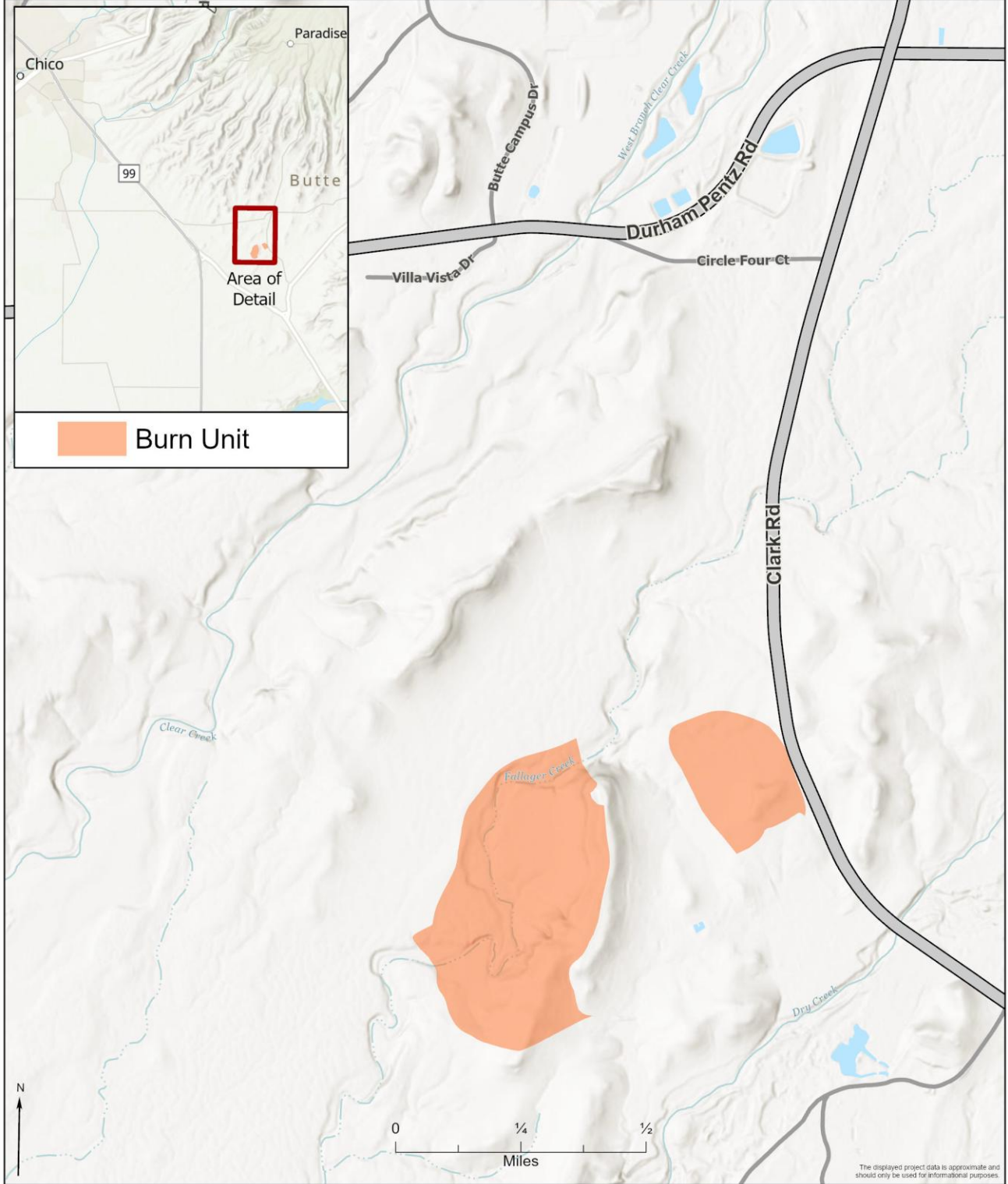
