

THE EPISTLE Sit


Following the Epistle either a Psalm or Hymn is sung by all (see Insert)






After the Prayer for the State of Christ's Church (Prayer Book p. 74), the Priest invites the Confession and all kneeling or sitting say...

Almighty God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, maker of all things, judge of all men: We acknowledge and bewail our manifold sins and wickedness, which we from time to time most grievously have committed, by thought, word, and deed, against thy divine Majesty, provoking most justly thy wrath and indignation against us. We do earnestly repent, and are heartily sorry for these our misdoings; the remembrance of them is grievous unto us, the burden of them is intolerable. Have mercy upon us, have mercy upon us, most merciful Father; for thy Son our Lord Jesus Christ's sake, forgive us all that is past; and grant that we may ever hereafter serve and please thee in newness of life, to the honor and glory of thy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Priest pronounces the absolution, the people reply **Amen.**The Priest offers the Comfortable words, after which he proceeds...





CANON OF THE MASS. all kneel

The Canon can be followed in of the Prayer Book on page 80. If Sung by the Choir alone, the Celebrant continues with the Eucharistic prayer during the Sanctus, and concludes during the Benedictus qui Venit. The Choir pauses after the Sanctus for the words of institution and elevations.

The Priest concludes O Father Almighty, world without end. And all respond Amën.




PRAYER OF HUMBLE ACCESS
