Who can attend? The people of the Diocese and honored guests, no invitation or tickets required.

What time should I arrive? You may arrive as early as 9:30 to be admitted to the foyer. Ushers will begin seating guests in the sanctuary at 10:15. The service begins promptly at 11 am.

Where can I park? On the street, or in parking lots adjacent to the Cathedral and at Boise High School, nearby.

What is distinctive about this service? The ordination and consecration of bishops is an ancient and sacred rite, outlined on pages 510-511 of the Book of Common Prayer. The Most Rev. Michael B. Curry presides. It is a joy-filled service of Presentation, Examination and Consecration, with Ministry of the Word and Holy Eucharist. It is an affirmation of the call to ministry in our baptismal covenant: forged on the cross, glorified in the Resurrection, called into action at Pentecost, and continually renewed in our lives.

How long is the service? Probably about 2 hours. The Cathedral is air-conditioned.

May I take photos? Yes, but no flashes are permitted, and you must stay in your seat.

What are the Covid precautions? Masks are required and no selfies are allowed with the Presiding Bishop.

Who can attend the reception? All are invited.

I can't get to Boise. How can I watch from home? The service will be live-streamed, beginning at 10:45 am, on the Diocese of Idaho's Facebook page and Youtube channel:
