Solution: **Stock Up on Jobz** is an app for kids looking to get money but it also helps them learn about the stock market because the money earned goes to an investing app.





If you had picked the “adult” option, you would have been prompted to fill out this screen to sign into your bank account, so you are able to pay kids for their work, and when you paid, it would just pull directly from your account.



This a “create an account” screen and is the same for both adults and children. You just input your birthday and address and you’re good to go. Also, for example, if you had picked do jobs on the first screen and are over 18 years old, you wouldn’t be able to make an account and vice versa.



If you're a kid and you paired our app with Robinhood, for example, your money earned from doing jobs will go directly to the "Buying power" tab and then the kid (maybe with the help of an adult) will invest in any stocks/crypto using the money in Buying power you earned.
