On **Saturday Nov 28**, the first weekend in Advent, let's spend time outdoors clearing away debris and vegetation from the graves of African Americans in this historic - and long neglected - cemetery in Richmond, where many of Richmond's African-American leaders of the 19th + 20th centuries, including Maggie L. Walker, rest. All Covid protocols are in place at the cemetery (they conduct temp checks, provide disposable gloves, etc.).

From **9AM-12PM** we will be the hands and feet of Jesus in our community as we clear the graves and headstones. Afterwards, at **12:15PM** we will have a socially distant bring-your-own-picnic lunch there at Evergreen or nearby (TBD).

NOTE: The Cemetery rules only allow ages 6+ to do clean up, but we will hold an **ALL AGES socially distant picnic lunch** there or nearby (TBD) at 12:15 that everyone is welcome to attend. If you have littles younger than 6, please join us for the picnic!
