

Halloween Paper Chains

Supplies:

- Cardstock or construction paper (black, green, and purple)
- Ribbon or string
- Wiggle eyes
- Markers
- Stapler or glue
- Template ([HERE](#))



Instructions:

1. Using the template, cut out the monster's hair and bolts from black paper.
2. Measure, draw, and cut out one rectangle from green paper, three rectangles from purple paper, and four rectangles from black paper.
3. Make the green rectangle into a ring by stapling the ends together.
4. Loop a purple rectangle through the ring previously made and staple the ends together. Repeat until all eight rings are joined together.
5. Stick the hair and bolts to the green ring.
6. Next, draw the face and stick two wiggle eyes on the green ring.
7. To finish, cut a length of ribbon, then loop and tie it through the green ring at the top of the paper chain.
8. Repeat these steps to create the bat and mummy, using the photo as a reference.
