

Paper Plate Spider

Supplies:

- Small paper plates (2 per spider)
- Paint of any color
- Googly eyes, varying sizes if you want
- Pipe cleaners (4 per spider)
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Glue



Instructions:

1. Paint the underside of two small paper plates and set them aside to let them dry completely.
2. When the paint has finished drying, cut four pipe cleaners in half to make eight spider legs.
3. Line up your two painted paper plates with the paint facing out on both sides and then place a staple at the top to connect them together.
4. Insert a spider legs in between the two plates about one inch and then staple it down between the two plates. Do this with all eight legs, with four on each side of the paper plates. Then place additional staples around the paper plates to close them shut.
5. Create a bend in each of the pipe cleaners to make them look like spider legs.
6. Glue on eight wiggly eyes of different sizes on the top of your spider. You could also use self-adhesive googly eyes so you don't have to wait for drying time.
7. Use a hole punch to punch a hole in the top of the paper plate spider and tie a white string through it so you can hang it up as if it's coming down it's spider web.
