

## ***Pom Pom Caterpillar***

### Supplies:

- Colored craft paper (for leaves)
- Large pom poms
- Small googly eyes
- Scissors
- Glue
- Hole punch
- Green marker



### Instructions:

1. Draw any leaf design you like and cut it out. Make sure it is a little bigger than your caterpillar.
2. Using a hole puncher, punch out a few holes around the edges of your leaf cut out. That way it can look like your caterpillar is happily munching on the tasty leaf.
3. After you've punched out a few holes, use a green marker to draw patterns on your leaf.
4. Grab a few pom poms and start to craft your caterpillar. You can use all of one color or mix it up. This would be a good time to let the kids choose different colors to make different caterpillar designs.
5. Glue the pom poms side by side to form the caterpillar's body. You can make them as long or as short as you like. Set your caterpillars aside on a flat surface to dry completely.
6. Once your caterpillar has dried, you can glue 2 googly eyes to the top of your first pom pom.
7. Once the caterpillar is dried, place it on the paper leaf and glue it down.
