

Thumbprint Heart Magnet

Supplies:

- Cardstock (bright white heavyweight paper works best)
- Acrylic paint or fingerprint ink pads
- Extra large clear glass gems (without any iridescent coating or finish), flat-backed marbles, cabochons, or glass floral stones
- Scissors
- Mod podge glue, B6000 adhesive, or another white PVC glue that dries clear and a foam brush
- Craft magnets (small round ceramic magnets work best)



Instructions:

1. Choose a flat surface to create thumbprints or fingerprints in the shape of hearts. Use a pencil to trace the glass stones and cut them out.
2. Press your thumb or finger into a fingerprint ink pad.
3. Stamp fingerprints or thumbprints to the precut cardstock to make a simple heart shape that is small enough to fit under the glass stone. Make sure to use fingers that are small enough to fit the size of the stone and ensure that the fingerprints are placed at a slight angle to each other.
4. Optional: use a permanent marker to draw faces on the heart fingerprints.
5. Place a drop of clear-drying adhesive on the flat side of the glass gem. Press the glass gem on top of the fingerprint heart to attach it to the cardstock.
6. Press down the glass gem, slightly twist it to distribute the glue evenly and remove any air bubbles.
7. Once the glue is dry, attach a small magnet to the back of the glass stone. Allow magnets to dry overnight.
