## Wooden Spoon Bat Craft

## Supplies:

- Wooden spoons
- Black construction paper
- Scrap of white paper
- Googly eyes
- Crafter's tape/Glue
- Paint and paintbrush
- Scissors



## Instructions:

- Paint the back side and edges of the spoon. No need to paint the front since you won't be able to see it.
- 2. Set the spoons aside to dry.
- 3. While waiting for the spoons to dry, cut out bat wings from black construction paper. Fold the construction paper in half and draw a bat wing shape, then cut out the wings along the fold. Or just use this template <a href="HERE">HERE</a>.
- 4. Once the spoons are completely dry, cut out two small black triangle ears from the black construction paper, and two small triangle fangs from the white paper. Attach them using glue. Attach the googly eyes.
- 5. Put some glue on the inside fold of the bat wings. Then carefully line up the spoon over the top and press down to secure it.
- 6. Gently fold the bat wings up over each side of the spoon. When you let go of the fold, the wings should be bending slightly up off the table.
- 7. Repeat steps for more bats!
