Cara Mía Theatre. and the Oak Cliff Cultural Center are excited to announce **The School of YES! Summer Camp**, a multidisciplinary arts academy for youth ages 7-14 and **Student Leaders ages 15-18**. From **June 21st – July 16th**, students will participate in **leadership classes taught by Cara Mía Theatre's La Siembra Fellow, Jodi Voice Yellowfish**. Classes are inspired by Jodi's Reclamation Talking Circles that took place earlier this year in which participants explored reclaiming time, who they are, their creativity, their and culture. Students will attend classes online over ZOOM **Monday – Friday**. **Student Leaders** are required to be present from **9:00 AM – 12:05 PM**. Students Leaders are also required to participate in the final performance at the **Texas Theatre (231 W Jefferson Blvd, Dallas, TX 75208) on July 16th from 4:30pm-7:00pm** The mission of The School of YES! is to give young people the skills to say “yes” to a future of their choice rather than feel pressured into a future defined by their environment.

Ten high school students ages 15-18 will also receive scholarships to participate as Student Leaders. Along with receiving a scholarship, Student Leaders will also receive a weekly stipend of \$50. *Additional interviews may be required, dates and times are TBD. 
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APPLICATION

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

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
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PARENTAL AGREEMENT
