

Target Area Contract Preference Act

What is TACPA?

The Target Area Contract Preference Act economic stimulus preference program was established to stimulate business investment in distressed areas of the state and create job opportunities for Californians for improving the economic vitality of their communities.

Any vendor whose bid is over \$100,000 may apply for Target Area Contract Preference Act (TACPA) preference. TACPA provides a preference for a California business that is located in the qualified zone.

How do you qualify for TACPA?

To determine if a business is located within a TACPA qualified zone visit the Interactive TACPA Map
