All donations have been distributed among 6 different Anaheim low-income communities. Initially, we walked around our different communities, to meet, see and write down what these families needed and if we would be able to help them out. Houseware items were given to adults only, diapers were handed to moms with their babies or pregnant women. All toys were handed to children only, we had more for boys. So the girls would get a girl toy of the few that we had. But many took a Ziploc plastic baggie with color pens, a choice of a headpiece, or a small item that they could use.

Many families shared with us and were beyond thankful to have received a mini-refrigerator, airbed, mattress, lamps, grills, coolers, microwaves, pillows, sleeping bags, housewares items, cloth, shoes and many more things from FOCUS during these difficult times of this pandemic situation. Many, if not most of these families do not have work thus no income and nowhere to ask for assistance to get income to buy diapers, clothes, and housewares items. All this along with the mini-refrigerators thankfully has helped to maintain their free food pantries refrigerated too! Others showed us that they

were sleeping on the floor because they had no choice but to move in to rent a living room or a bedroom because they couldn't afford full rent. Believe it or not some of them are living up to 3-4 families in one apartment because the rents are so high. Many of them were living in a very bad situation where they didn't even have a gallon of milk for their children, a bed where to lay themselves, and were too afraid to seek assistance because of lack of legal documents. I also wanted to share we have also helped with 15 homeless people with food and cloth, and them too were very appreciated!
