Welcome to the New Year! We are in the New Testament portion of Root 66 on Sunday mornings. It's been a great journey thus far and we have a really exciting portion of the road ahead of us in the "Explanation" part of A.M.P.E.C. which will take us from Romans to Jude.

During the month of February, we'll take a 4-week Sunday morning detour that we're calling "Are We There Yet?" Carmel has a great mission taken from the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20: (read this out loud) "Carmel is committed to making disciples of those Nearest, our Neighbors, and the Nations." This statement describes WHAT we will do as we move forward in the vision Good has given us as a church. But during the month of February, we'll unpack the WHY and the HOW. What is the compelling reason behind this mission? And HOW do we make disciples?

The "Are We There Yet?" detour will culminate with our Life in Christ Conference on Saturday, March 3 (8:30am - 12:30pm). Plan to bring your family and join me for important morning of practical equipping on HOW to make disciples.

95% of what we do on a daily basis is driven by our habits and only 5% from conscious decisions**. I'm praying through that and asking the Lord to reveal to me what habits drive my life. Would you join me in that prayer? Let's commit in 2018 to make it a "habit" to pursue the Lord like never before.
