Once again in 2022 the women of our district stepped up to support the mission and ministries that allow us to faithfully serve others. Following is a summary of the ways in which we helped to serve women, youth, and children:

We sent \$6,181 to the greater UMW/UWF from pledges.

We gave \$1,500 to the West Side Community House.

We sent \$740 to RAHAB.

We gave \$1,000 to the Akron Canton Regional Food bank (with a request that the money be used in Stark County).

The Love Offering for 2023 will go to the Heart of Ohio Diaper Bank. The name has changed from the Stark County Diaper Bank because they are now serving five other counties as well as Stark. We will be collecting diapers, size Premie through size 7, girls pullups, boys pull-ups, adult incontinence sizes x small to xx Large, period pads, and tampons, and of course, money for this project at our April 29<sup>th</sup> and our October 7<sup>th</sup> meetings. Grab a jar and start filling it with your money or grab your coupons and watch for sales to buy diapers or supplies for this very worthwhile project.

The diaper bank's mission is to offer support to families in time of need by providing access to diapers through a network of community partners. All donated diapers are repackaged into packs of 15 or 25 diapers to distribute to the partners who give them to clients.
