SUBJECT: **COVID-19 Pandemic—Weekly Update**

Dear friends,

We are pleased to share the weekly update with you.

I. Determining the Number of People in Attendance for Mass, Now and in the Future

We invite the parishes to first read the announcements from the Province concerning the number of people permitted indoors, as well as the conditions that must be met in order to determine what must be done to accommodate the realities in each parish.

YOU DO NOT HAVE TO AWAIT PERMISSION FROM THE DIOCESE TO MODIFY THE CONTROLS IN PLACE IN YOUR PARISH TO ENSURE THE APPROPRIATE NUMBER OF PEOPLE GATHER FOR MASS. THE DIOCESE WILL NO LONGER PUBLISH DECLARATIONS ON THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS PERMITTED TO ATTEND; PLEASE FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS PUT FORTH BY THE GOVERNMENT AT ALL TIMES.

We invite you to refer to Protocol IV “At A Glance,” published on May 29, 2020, to ensure you are adhering to all necessary hygiene measures, regardless of the number of people permitted at any given moment, in order to minimize the risk of transmitting COVID-19.
