

Rules and Expectations for the 2020 Mardi Gras Queen

1. The contestant chosen as the 2020 Mardi Gras Queen agrees to be available to reign over the 2020 Mardi Gras Festivities including any planned activities for November 1, 2020.
2. The 2020 Mardi Gras Queen's reign is not complete until she has attended and participated in the following events:
 - a. 2021 Mardi Gras Queen Pageant on October 16, 2021
 - b. 2021 Mardi Gras Parade on October 30, 2021.
 - c. In the event that these above dates have to be changed, the Pinckneyville Chamber of Commerce will work with the Mardi Gras Queen to accommodate her schedule as best as possible.
3. The 2020 Mardi Gras Queen will be expected to make personal appearances during her reigning year as arranged for her by the Pinckneyville Chamber of Commerce.
4. The 2020 Mardi Gras Queen will be expected to champion and organize a community service project benefiting a non-profit organization in Pinckneyville.
5. The 2020 Mardi Gras Queen understands that if for any reason she is not able to fulfill her obligations and/or the Pinckneyville Chamber of Commerce feels that she is not able to fulfill her obligations as the reigning Queen for the entire year, the Pinckneyville Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to require an immediate relinquishment of her title and all privileges to said title (including the crown, sashes, trophy, and prize money not yet awarded by that date) and to be succeeded by the next eligible runner-up.
6. The 2020 Mardi Gras Queen will receive \$1,500 in prize money upon completion of her reign which includes the 2021 Mardi Gras Queen Pageant and Parade.

2020 Mardi Gras Queen's Court

Following the 2020 Mardi Gras Queen's Pageant, the Queen's Court will receive the following prize money:

- 1st runner up - \$500
- 2nd runner up - \$250
- 3rd runner up - \$100
