For this project, we'll be teaching you how to use Fujitsu scanners to preserve memories. Then you and your high school buddy will create a "Digital Scrapbook" that you can share with family and friends.

All you need to do is:

- Sign Up on Site in Advance
- Choose a theme that means a lot to you
- Gather relevant documents, photos, records and other items (can even be 3-dimensional!)
- Bring the items and their stories to 30th St. Senior Center on October 21
- Spend a day making new friends, learning about technology and preserving memories to share with family and friends



Here are some theme suggestions to get you started:

"Our Family Recipes" – handwritten recipes passed down through generations, heirloom cooking tools (an egg beater, for example), photos from family meals and gatherings

"The Home Country" – immigration documents, travel records, photos of the homestead

"Remembering My Mother/Father" – handwritten notes and cards, birth certificate, photos, favorite recipes, special trinkets/pieces of jewelry, medals/decorations, certificates of achievement

"Dear Diary" – handwritten letters, personal journals, post cards
