Dear FIU family,

The Pfizer vaccine is available at FIU for students, faculty, staff, retirees and eligible members of their households.

First doses of the Pfizer vaccine will be available on **Tuesday, June 8 and Thursday, June 10**. Children ages 12-17 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Everyone, including children, must bring a photo ID or birth certificate to show proof of age.

[Vaccine appointments are now open](#) and will be given on a first come, first served basis. [Please register for an appointment](#) as soon as possible using your FIU credentials. Please note that the Pfizer vaccine requires a second shot three weeks after the first shot. You or the child being vaccinated must return for the second dose on **Tuesday, June 29 and Thursday, July 1**.

At FIU, we strive to help our Panther family stay safe and healthy. Please remember that vaccinated or not, we must all continue to observe COVID-19 mitigation guidelines. The use of face coverings is strongly encouraged while indoors. Also, before arriving on campus each day, every member of the university community must complete the P3 app questionnaire. Together, we can ensure everyone's wellbeing as we bring more of the university community back to our campuses safely.
