Dates-June 17-22, 2018

Cost-Deposit \$50 per person by April 8. The rest of the cost will be paid through funds raised at the youth auction.

Chaperones-Jeff Lowery, Yajaira Hernandez, Brenda Bateman, Aaron Lopez. Depending on how many youth sign up for the trip we can and will add more adults.

Travel Schedule-We will likely leave in mid morning on Sunday June 17 (bring a sack lunch) and return Friday late afternoon. The drive is approximately 4 hours. We will rent vans to transport the group.

What kind of community service projects will we do?

We will do anything from painting homes, cleaning yards of garbage and debris, chopping wood for elders, mowing, weeding gardens, working at a homeless shelter, light construction projects, or maybe even working at one of our local pow-wows.

Where are we staying?

WE will be staying on the reservation at the All Nations Center in Wapato. This facility is equipped with plenty of rooms to sleep in. Guys and girls will sleep in separate rooms, including married adult leaders. Individuals will need to bring their own sleeping bags, pillows, sleeping pads or air mattresses that are twin size or smaller (Slam trips does not provide a pump for the air mattresses).
