On day 1 it was Kelsey who took the time to go over the good, the bad, the ups the downs... so many downs...Kelsey was our therapist when I was falling apart when it seemed like all I got was bad news...From day 1, she advocated for Gabriela like she was her own...You have an amazing NICU and the Garay family is forever grateful for the 148 days spent with you all.” Kelsey is a graduate of UMass School of Nursing and has been in our NICU since 2016.
