

Rev. Lee Anne's schedule

It is my great pleasure to be serving as UUCNH's minister. I am pleased to be getting to know you and am enjoying participating in as many activities as I reasonably can. It has taken some time to settle in and settle on a regular schedule. It is important that you know when and how to get in touch with me. So, here's an explanation of my work schedule.

When I work:

Generally, I work from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday through Friday, and 8:30 to 3:30 on Sunday. Saturday hours vary. Fridays are dedicated to preparing the message for Sunday's service. Mondays are my day off. When I have an evening meeting, I may begin my workday a bit later in the day in order to accommodate the evening meeting.

With a few exceptions, UU ministers are in the pulpit 3 out of 4 Sundays. The work week prior to being in the pulpit is generally a 6-day week. The weekend in which a UU minister is not in the pulpit is generally a long weekend in order to balance out the three prior short weekends. I will be following this schedule. So, in the week before I am not in the pulpit, I will be taking Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday off. This creates a rhythm that is predictable and supportive of my work/life balance.

Where I work:

For the time being, I am working from the church's office on Tuesdays from 10 am to 6 pm and on Sundays from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm, in order to accommodate sharing the first floor with Bellwood. Otherwise, I will be working from home, though I will be at the church for some part of many Saturdays preparing for Sunday's service or participating in UUCNH weekend activities.

Given the vagaries of a minister's schedule, it is always prudent to make an appointment to assure that I will be available. I have numerous regularly scheduled in-person meetings and Zoom calls throughout the month.
