



Pennsylvania Voters Want An Independent Redistricting Commission

“We heard that loud and clear from voters asked to sign our redistricting reform petition as they left their polling places. Our volunteers, working 2 to 3 hour shifts, collected over 4400 signatures at 48 polling places in 27 counties. Responses echoed multiple polls this year that show voters of every party, or no party, overwhelmingly want independent redistricting commissions.
