

# Reach Out

Riley Kids are transported throughout Riley Hospital in red wagons. Have you ever thought about how the children get to the hospital? Most of them arrive at Riley in a family vehicle or by ambulance.

## BUT

There are children who are not able to travel to Riley by traditional means of transportation, for a variety of reasons. Without the **Reach Out** program they may not be able to get to the medical care they need. That is where we, as Kiwanians who care, come in.

**Reach Out** is a program in the Indiana District of Kiwanis that provides transportation to and from Riley Hospital for Children for those children who do not have means of transportation to needed health care. Through the Kiwanians in Direct Service (K.I.D.S.) Committee, Kiwanians in Indiana provide transportation to and from the hospital for children throughout the state who have no other means of travelling there. Working with Social Workers at the hospital, Riley Kids who need transport to care at Riley are paired with Kiwanians who volunteer to ensure they make it to and from the hospital.

## Because it is what we do

As volunteers in service to the children of our communities, we care. The reach out program relies upon us. Each Division in the Indiana District of Kiwanis has a reach out Advocate and each Kiwanis Club has been asked to provide an Advocate as well. When the call comes to provide transportation for a Riley Kid, our Advocates jump into action to ensure that child gets to the hospital for essential medical care. Liability waivers are provided for the drivers and must be signed by the accompanying parent(s) or guardian(s).
