

Volunteer Opportunities at the 2022 Kiwanis International Convention

No one demonstrates hospitality quite like Indiana Kiwanians, and we have the chance to do it again at the 2022 Kiwanis International Convention, June 8-11. As the host district, there are several opportunities for us to be involved and welcome Kiwanis members from all over the world to Indianapolis.

On-line sign-up for specific host committee volunteer shifts will open on March 19th, during the district's Mid-Year Conference. As with almost everything in our world, a few volunteer opportunities have changed due to COVID protocols. For those of you that volunteered at the 2015 convention, you will notice a few changes.

Airport Greeting – This team welcomes Kiwanis members as they arrive at the Indianapolis International Airport and provides information and answers questions as needed. This team works at the airport and volunteers do not need to be registered for the convention to assist on this team.

Days: Monday (possibly), Tuesday and Wednesday
Greet arriving Kiwanis members with signs and smiles.

Provide information on the convention schedule and transportation options to hotels.

International Marketplace Support – This team provides support for various activities taking place in the main convention hall. Volunteers for this team do need to be registered for the convention.

Days: Wednesday, Thursday, Friday


Provide international members with registration packets. This is a great opportunity for those who have knowledge of a language other than English.

Pass out t-shirts, tickets and wristbands for the Victory Field event on Thursday evening. (There will also be the opportunity to do this at Victory Field for late-arriving members.)

Assist with meal packing service project on Friday morning. These volunteers should be able to lift and move boxes of packaged meals.

Welcome Desk – This team staffs a welcome desk in the convention center to provide information on the city, dining options, transportation options, directions, convention schedule questions, and other questions posed by attendees. Volunteers for this team do need to be registered for the convention.





Days: Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday
Answer questions and provide assistance to convention attendees.
Distribute dining and activity information provided by Visit Indy.
Serve as roaming photographers throughout the convention center to help attendees capture their visit at various photo spots.

Having the Kiwanis International Convention in our own backyard is a tremendous opportunity. With the convention only a short drive away, Hoosier Kiwanians can save the expense of air travel and if you live in central Indiana, you could also commute and save hotel costs. You can enjoy the celebration, take advantage of the education, and conduct the business of the organization easier than ever! And don't forget, we have a candidate for International Trustee this year and we can all be a part of helping Past Governor Steve Ingram get elected.

Following are answers to a few frequently asked questions about volunteering at Kiwanis International Convention.

Is there an incentive for me to volunteer? Of course, the fun of showing off our Hoosier hospitality is the best incentive! Host committee volunteers will also receive a \$25 gift certificate to use at the Kiwanis Store.

Do I need to be registered to volunteer? Yes, for most volunteer positions you need to be registered for the convention. If you are unable to register, you can volunteer with the Airport Greeting team.

May my spouse/partner volunteer if he/she is not a Kiwanis member? Yes, guests may volunteer but must also be registered for the convention. There are guest registration rates that are slightly lower than the regular member rates.

When can I sign up? Specific shifts and schedules will be available via the iVolunteer on-line system beginning March 19th. Instructions for accessing the iVolunteer platform will be available at the Indiana District Mid-Year Conference and will also be sent via email.

Can I volunteer for the Host Committee and Past Governor Steve's campaign efforts? Yes, you can help with both! Just remember not to wear campaign items while you are serving as a Host Committee volunteer, save those for campaign activities.
