



BENEFITS AND CREDITS AVAILABLE TO YOU

New to Canada?

You only **need to apply once** to find out if you are eligible for benefit and credit payments. Then, as a resident of Canada, you need to **do your taxes every year** to continue getting payments.

We use the information from your tax return to calculate your federal benefit and credit payments, and **any related provincial and territorial payments**.

You could get up to:

\$6,400

annually per child in
Canada child benefit payments

\$552

annually in GST/HST credit payments
+ \$145 annually per child

\$1,868

for the working income tax benefit.
You could also apply for
advance payments

\$2,730

annually in child disability benefit
payments if your child is eligible for
the disability tax credit
