



I-90, WASHINGTON STATE LINE TO COEUR d' ALENE

State Highway 41 Interchange

In 2023, the Idaho Transportation Department will continue reconstructing the interchange at I-90 and SH-41 in Post Falls.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION: 2023

WORK WILL INCLUDE:

- Build three permanent bridges on I-90 for eastbound traffic and begin work on adjacent westbound bridges.
- Finish one temporary bridge over SH-41 to maintain traffic flow during construction.
- Shift traffic on I-90 to the outside to construct the new westbound and eastbound lanes and bridges in the median.
- Begin work on Seltice/SH-41 alignment.

ANTICIPATED TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

- Two lanes will be open with reduced shoulders.
- The speed limit will be lowered to 55 mph on I-90 and 25 mph on SH-41 and Seltice Way.
- Intermittent lane restrictions will occur on I-90 at night.
 - Overnight work hours: 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. and 10 p.m. during special events.
 - Nighttime work will require lighting.
- Construction may be noisy and dusty.

PROCESS AND SCHEDULE

YEAR 1	Construction begins	Summer 2022 – Early 2023
YEAR 2	Construction continues ★ WE ARE HERE	Spring 2023 – Early 2024
YEAR 3	Construction continues; westbound “loop” off-ramp closed	Spring 2024 – Early 2025
YEAR 4	Construction expected to be complete	2025

IMPROVEMENTS

- Reconstructing over a mile of I-90 and making room for future widening of the interstate.
- Replacing the SH-41 Interchange with a new design. All ramps will come together at a single point and be controlled by one traffic signal.
- Improving the SH-41 and Mullan Avenue intersection and local connectivity south of the interchange.
- Adding two underpasses, one bridge and one signal to provide safer, easier movements for pedestrians and cyclists through the interchange and nearby trails.

FUNDING

ITD is using several funding sources, including the Transportation Expansion and Congestion Mitigation (TECM) funds that are part of Governor Little's Leading Idaho initiative. The TECM program allows ITD to accelerate project timelines to address rapid growth and build critical infrastructure today that would otherwise take many years to fund and build.
