The Profile of the Executive Director for Solidarity with South Sudan

- i. Position is open to all consecrated men and women who are endorsed by their Superior General.
- ii. The candidate will promote within the members in South Sudan, in the operation of Solidarity activities and in relations with other partners, the mission, vision and values espoused by Solidarity.
- iii. It is an advantage to have African experience, as well as intercultural community living experience.
- iv. Person supervises the management in day to day running of the four projects in South Sudan while promoting local leadership and governance.
- v. Person will oversee the implementation of the Strategic Plan 2024-2027.
- vi. Person is responsible for the welfare of all members serving in South Sudan, promoting the Solidarity expression of religious witness and attentive to the Spiritual motivation of members in South Sudan and that of participating congregations.
- vii. The position is based in Juba and answers directly to the President and Board of Solidarity
- viii. She/he will maintain a constructive relationship with individual Bishops and with the Bishops' Conference (SSSCBC) following the orientation given in the MoU with SSSCBC
- ix. She/he will manage, remotely, the Office in Rome and participate in the meetings of the Board of Governors, the Solidarity Finance Committee and other bodies as needed.
- x. Person requires a capacity for maintaining good relations with our Partner Organisations including Friends in Solidarity, based in USA.
- xi. In collaboration with the Board, the person will be responsible for the recruiting of new Solidarity personnel to the projects, both religious and lay.
- xii. The mandate is for three years, renewable once, hence the new executive director should be available for a minimum of three years.
