Andy Happel, a Scarborough resident, is a concert violinist and fiddler who has shared the stage with symphonies, pop stars, and country music luminaries alike and has toured extensively with the likes of Guster, Train, Matchbox 20 and the Dave Matthews Band.

We will wrap up the evening with a fantastic fireworks show, scheduled to begin at 9:15 pm. Please be sure to bring your blanket or folding chair and find your spot early.
