

10 Tips to Successful Hearing Aid CARE AND USE

1 Remove your hearing aids at night.

Open the battery doors all the way every night.

3 Every night, use a clean, dry tissue to gently wipe the outer part of your hearing aids. If you have earmolds, use the cleaning tool loop to clean the earmold's openings.





Keep hearing aids away from extreme heat and cold.

5 Do not wear hearing aids while applying makeup or hair products.

Keep hearing aids and batteries away from children and pets.

Replace batteries when low battery beep occurs. Your size 13 battery will last approximately 2 weeks, size 312 battery: approximately 7 days, and size 10 battery: approximately 5 days.

Remove the sticker from the back of the battery. Place it on your calendar every time you replace your battery. Wait a couple of minutes after removing the sticker before inserting the battery into your hearing aid.

Please schedule a checkup appointment every 3 months. We will inspect your ears for wax, as well as professionally clean and check your hearing aids to ensure that you continue to receive the full benefits from your devices.
