Three Valuable Reference Points:


1. People with either mild or moderate-severe hearing loss were more likely to discuss their hearing with their family doctor (43% and 50%, respectively), followed by an ENT, audiologist, and hearing instrument specialist (HIS).
2. The most important social network influence is the family doctor; in fact, 1 in 5 people (21%) indicated they would be highly motivated to get hearing aids if their family doctor recommended hearing aids. Only about 15% would be highly motivated if their family doctor thought their job performance suffered or if their family doctor thought they would not get hearing aids.
