From the Executive Director's Desk...

Dear Supporters of PLS,

As a new year begins it causes one to reflect on what has been completed and to be so thankful for

the goodness and generosity of those who have provided Precious Life with 30 years of service. Reflecting on these past 30 years has brought back memories of the dreams of how we could help those who needed a loving home to birth their children. Please allow us to say thank you in a very sincere way to each of YOU for YOU have made that difference for those we serve and continue to serve. So we embark on how we will move into 2020 and beyond to enhance the lives of the women and children that continue needing our assistance.

We are in the midst of revamping and bringing all of our Health and Education Program into current resources, not only updating the majority of the required birth and delivery materials, but the life skills, health, nutrition, safety and job search resources. We are installing a new Media Server, which allows residents to access materials easily on line on the classroom computers that are being upgraded, and can be used with headsets for individual viewing and listening. New and larger monitors were secured to give residents better viewing of these materials. Remembering back 30 years when we only had a television, tape recorder or video to help provide the pre and post delivery materials for our residents makes us realize how quickly those years passed.

In sharing with you these developments to meet the needs of our residents, we once again thank YOU, our donors and funders who provide the resources to update and upgrade our classroom and resources. Visual learners seem to be what the majority of our clients are.

Over the years we have shared how our population has evolved since we opened our doors. Our residents are older, on the street longer, and coming through our doors later in their pregnancies. All of these elements have caused us to recognize that their lives, whether by choice or circumstances, have more traumatic issues which we have to address in a short period of time to help them prepare for a safe birth and delivery for these little ones that will soon arrive. So many of YOU offer on-hand help as mentors, tutors, instructors, sponsors and friends and that is what makes the difference in the women's lives. THANK YOU!

As we look ahead to this New Year with excitement, we plan events to provide the funding and support for the resources and services needed to assist our women. Our upcoming gala on April 25th at the Sea Cliff Country Club will be the first of this year's fund raisers, and we have many new and exciting surprises for that evening. We look forward to

having YOU join us at "Dancing Under the Stars" to celebrate the success of allowing more than 3,000 women to change their lives because of your generosity.

Our Thrift Shop continues to provide a significant amount of support for the program as our social enterprise, and we are so grateful to all the volunteers that help us each day. We invite those of you with a little extra time to join our volunteer team, become a regular shopper and bring a friend to see if they might find an item or two they can't live without.

Sharing the shelter story and what has been accomplished in these past 30 years is one of my greatest joys. Being able to talk with the children that have been here and hearing how their lives were saved and how much they appreciate what was provided for their moms while in residence and then beyond is awesome. It does bring tears to one's eyes to see them marry, have children of their own and succeed in their goals. YOU have done a mighty work since 1989, and we are so blessed that YOU continue to walk with us as we strive to make a difference, no matter how small, in the life of every woman who walks through our door. Planting the seed is what we can begin to do, and we may never know what becomes of each seed. 




