The scope of NMSK includes over 110 clinicians, over 25 residents and fellows and over 200,000 patient visits and 6700 surgeries annually in the areas of Neurology, Neurological Critical Care, Neurosurgery, the Pain and Healing Center, Orthopedics, Spine Surgery, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Physical Therapy and Podiatry. The service line boasts the state's top ranked Rehabilitation Institute.
