In the role of CEO of CUIMC, this distinguished position in academic medicine serves as the leader of Columbia University's academic medical center campus which is considered one of the most preeminent, comprehensive and progressive academic medical centers in the United States.

The **EVP/Dean/CEO** is the Chief Academic Officer of the *CUVCPS/CUIMC* and is responsible for advancing and integrating its research, teaching and clinical service missions, and in this capacity, reports to the **President of Columbia University**, in the role of an Executive Vice President of the University.

The Dean leads CUVCPS/CUIMC through innovative, effective and responsible management of resources, and by leveraging existing assets, but does so in a highly collaborative environment. As a result, the Dean must demonstrate a personal communication style and integrity that fosters an environment of trust, teamwork, accountability, innovation and excellence for all constituents within CUVCPS/CUIMC and importantly as an integral component of the University at large. The duties and responsibilities include setting the *strategic direction* of CUVCPS/CUIMC. The Dean provides leadership for all research, education, service/outreach, and clinical programs in the CUVCPS/CUIMC. The Dean has responsibility for leading the regular academic review of departments (and their chairs) and for overseeing space utilization in the CUVCPS/CUIMC. Within the confines of University Bylaws, the Dean appoints the basic science and clinical department chairs. In addition to the department chairs, the Dean is responsible for the oversight of multiple *Institutes* and *Centers of Excellence*. The successful candidate will possess an M.D. degree (or equivalent).
