The Vice Chair will possess an MD degree from an accredited medical school and be clinically active. The Vice Chair must have the clinical credibility and the relevant experience necessary to gain an academic appointment at Rutgers NJMS. Additionally, a competitive candidate will possess UME, GME, and CME educational administrative experience with a proven track record of educational leadership and excellence in teaching. Experience in an academic/teaching environment is required.
