The Surgical Director is responsible for coordinating and directing the lung transplant surgical services for Temple University Hospital. This includes maintaining UNOS certification and CMS certification for both transplant programs and continuing to increase the volume of procedures performed.

The primary focus of the Surgical Director will be the continued expansion of the lung transplant program. The Surgical Director's clinical responsibilities will also include a full spectrum of cardiothoracic surgical procedures.

The incoming Surgical Director will be a respected academic surgeon with a distinguished record of clinical care, teaching, research, leadership and administration. Candidates must possess an M.D. or M.D. /Ph.D. with active board certification in Surgery as well as Thoracic and Cardiac Surgery; and credentials that will support a faculty appointment at the rank of Associate Professor/ Professor is preferred.
