The Penn State Cancer Institute (PSCI) is seeking applications and nominations for the position of Associate Director for Clinical Research.

The Penn State Cancer Institute is on a path to become an NCI designated cancer center. Located on the Hershey, PA campus, PSCI benefits greatly from beautiful new outpatient facilities and its status as the only academic health center in a patient catchment area of almost four million people. In 2015, there were 2,320 analytic cases of cancer seen at the Hershey campus and volumes consistently grow year over year. Collaborations with other regional systems supplement the Hershey campus for clinical and translational trials.

One of the last significant challenges for PSCI on the road to designation is to expand clinical trials, especially investigator-initiated, and to increase accruals generally. The next Director will have the resources to recruit other physician scientists; to develop training programs for faculty looking to enhance their efforts in this area; and to cultivate collaborations with the many basic scientists found on both Hershey and University Park campuses.

The ideal candidate will be a nationally recognized physician scientist with a strong track record of funding and discovery.
