The Chair will lead physician collaboration, planning, recruiting and will approve administrative policies and guidelines to ensure the quality and measured outcomes of programs are meeting the highest standards. The successful candidate will promote close collaboration and alignment between system member hospitals in the region. The medical center also provides postgraduate residency and fellowship training programs and has maintained a strong academic commitment through its partnership with the Geisel School of Medicine.
