Further, as the primary teaching affiliate of the University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine, NorthShore is dedicated to excellence in its academic mission and supports teaching and research. Some 300 residents, fellows, and medical students are at NorthShore facilities as part of the University of Chicago training program.

NorthShore’s Department of Medicine is the largest clinical department in the system and includes a full range of medical subspecialties. During that time the Department has increased the number of professional staff members to approximately 1,000 physicians, including 430 employed and over 500 affiliated physicians. In addition, the DOM supports over 100 medical residents and fellows. The Department is poised for continued growth and the next Chair will play a key role in developing a strategic vision and establishing internal and external relationships to take the Department to the next level of excellence.
