The candidate will be either a physician-scientist or scientist with a proven track record of extramural funding. While the candidate does not need to have a research lab focused solely on cancer *per se*, they do need to have an interest in a translational application that interfaces with cancer and preferably aligns with the goals and missions of the Knight Cancer Center and the Cancer Early Detection Advanced Research Center (CEDAR), which is a key partner in this recruitment

Qualified candidates will possess a PhD, MD, MD/PhD or an equivalent doctorate level degree or other appropriate terminal degree from an accredited higher education institution and experience that warrants an appointment as an Associate or Full Professor.
