H/she will serve as an effective spokesperson to interface among faculty members, institute and department chairs, the school's Appointment, Promotion and Tenure Committee, and appropriate departmental committees. They will advise and interact productively, assuring that there is an efficient and accurate mechanism for processing, keeping and accessing records for the large number of existing and potential faculty members who are employees of GCSOM and the Geisinger Health System. The successful candidate will have experience facilitating understanding of the appointments and promotions process by faculty members, chairs, and administrators.

The Associate Dean will be an emotionally intelligent academic leader with oversight of mentoring programs for the development of talented faculty members with primary appointments in the Department of Medical Education. H/she will institute a faculty mentorship program in order to maximize academic accomplishments, leadership potential, educational innovation, and areas of feasible research productivity.
