The Virginia Tech Carilion (VTC) Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Medicine is a strong and growing presence in regional healthcare. Our Department is based in Roanoke Virginia and has clinical, educational, and research sites throughout the region. Our Faculty are based in Roanoke at the Carilion Clinic (a Top 100 Hospital; https://www.carilionclinic.org/), in Radford at the Carilion New River Valley Hospital, at the Salem VAMC, and at the Catawba Hospital. We are part of the VTC School of Medicine (http://medicine.vtc.vt.edu/about/), one of the newest and most innovative medical schools in the nation. Director of Emergency Psychiatry:

We focus on interprofessional education and seek to build a platform of clinical services and research in collaboration with the VTC SOM and the VTCRI. Board certification in General Adult Psychiatry or a Subspecialty required.

Director of Ambulatory Care:

Carilion Clinic currently supports adult, child/adolescent, and geriatric programs at multiple sites in the Carilion Clinic system. We are looking for an academic clinician who can develop and support a cross-platform program serving patient populations with diverse needs and provide leadership to a dedicated and skilled group of interdisciplinary clinicians and trainees. We focus on interprofessional education and seek to build a platform of clinical services and research in collaboration with the VTC SOM and the VTCRI. Board certification in General Adult Psychiatry or a Subspecialty required.

Director of Medical Psychiatry:

We seek a psychiatrist at any seniority level to grow our consultation/ liaison program and expand our service delivery to medical and surgical specialty clinics. As the Department's key interface in a six hospital system, the flagship facility of over 700 beds serves as a Level 1 Trauma center and tertiary referral center for a catchment area spanning over 200 miles and 1,000,000 persons. Opportunities exist to develop programs in collaboration with orthopedics (pain management), OB/GYN, pediatrics, infectious disease, dermatology, etc. Teaching service development and extraordinary collaborative research opportunities are an important component of this opportunity. Board certification in General Adult Psychiatry or a Subspecialty required; dual boards in a medical specialty preferred.

Director of Telepsychiatry:

We seek a psychiatrist at any seniority level to drive the growth and development of our telehealth program. Experience in programmatic implementation of telehealth initiatives at a local or regional level would position the potential applicant to build and lead a dynamic program that we seek to integrate into care primary care and specialty care delivery, training, and research. We are currently involved in multiple clinical efforts targeting our support of Carilion's growing network of six hospitals and 45 patient centered medical homes across 240 miles of western Virginia through synchronous and asynchronous models. These efforts are supported in part by \$750,000 of grants to develop and implement innovative care delivery initiatives. Opportunities exist to develop integrated undergraduate and graduate medical education in these efforts. Board certification in General Adult Psychiatry or a Subspecialty required.
