The University of Massachusetts Medical School (UMMS) seeks a distinguished and accomplished leader to serve as the next Chair of the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health. Led since 1998 by Dr. Daniel Lasser, the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health (“Department”) has, throughout its history, pioneered novel approaches devoted to clinical care, medical and health professions education, research, and health policy, all with an unwavering commitment to the health of populations who are most at risk. Among the largest and most well-respected departments of its kind, the program graduated its first residents in 1976 and has since operationalized an expansive structure focused on training across a variety of community settings, reflecting the healthcare needs of the Commonwealth.

The next Chair will be expected to maintain the Department as a critical component of the healthcare safety net for the region and the Commonwealth and to serve as a key strategic partner to the executive leadership of both UMMS and UMass Memorial Medical Center (“UMMMC”), particularly in matters related to primary care and population health. The incumbent will steward the considerable resources of the Department and its affiliate groups and will work to grow those resources philanthropically, in advocating for the Department internally, and through an emphasis on increasing scholarly and clinical output.

The Chair will oversee all academic and healthcare services delivered under the aegis of the Department, promoting teaching, innovation in primary care delivery and research, and will guide faculty to find solutions to complicated problems as they advocate for their patients and their communities.
