The President is responsible for the management and development of nearly 110 employees, an overall \$20.9 million budget (OHSU Foundation \$17.6M, Doernbecher Foundation \$3.3M), and the engagement of nearly 28,000 donors to OHSU over the past three years.

The President of the OHSU Foundation acts as the chief development officer and strategic leader for the Foundation working closely with both the Foundation Board of Trustees and OHSU on behalf of its fundraising initiatives and relationships; provides advice to the University President and management team regarding their fundraising priorities; and leads the Foundation's senior management team.

This broad range of support places OHSU among Oregon's top beneficiaries of private philanthropy. And it makes the OHSU Foundation, with more than \$1.09 billion in assets, one of the largest public university foundations in the Northwest.
