The University of Kentucky College of Medicine invites applications and seeks nominations for the position of Chief of Dermatology.

The University of Kentucky College of Medicine seeks a visionary Chief with a successful record of achievement in academic medicine and extensive administrative experience. The predominant criteria for appointment as Chief includes the proven ability to deliver excellent patient care while training future leaders in dermatology. The successful candidate will also have a record of advancing the field through innovative research and scholarly activity. Candidates should also demonstrate the ability to develop synergy with primary care and other physicians throughout the surrounding areas to assist in our efforts to expand access to care and outreach through education and technology. Candidates must be board certified or board eligible.

Responsibilities include patient care in **General Dermatology** and teaching of residents and medical students. Research is encouraged but not required. The Dermatology clinic is located in a newly opened, freestanding multidisciplinary clinic that offers 85,000 square feet of clinic space and new equipment.

The **University of Kentucky** is one of few universities in the nation to have all six health science colleges (Medicine, Dentistry, Health Sciences, Nursing, Pharmacy and Public Health) all on one campus and is well-positioned to pursue inter-professional health care education and collaborative research. UK has developed a 20-year, \$2.5 billion plan to construct an innovative academic medical campus to advance the growth of research and health education university-wide.

UK Healthcare ranks among the Top 30 academic medical centers in size and Top 50 in NIH Funding. The College of Medicine, located in scenic Lexington, Kentucky, consists of 7 basic science departments, 17 clinical departments and 19 interdisciplinary centers/institutes/programs. The UK Markey Cancer Center was designated by the National Cancer Institute (NCI) in 2013, becoming the only NCI-designated cancer center in the state.
