Geisinger is an integrated health services organization widely recognized for its innovative use of technology and the development of innovative care delivery models. Geisinger had its beginnings in the small community of Danville, located in central Pennsylvania along the northern branch of the Susquehanna River. In 1915, at the age of 85, Abigail A. Geisinger founded the 63 -bed George F. Geisinger Memorial Hospital in memory of her late husband, famously saying, "Make my hospital right; make it the best."

Geisinger Commonwealth School of Medicine (GCSOM) offers a community- based model of undergraduate medical education with regional campuses in Atlantic City, Danville, Sayre, Scranton and Wilkes-Barre. The school's innovative Doctor of Medicine (MD) degree curriculum, focused on caring for people in the context of their lives and their community, attracts the next generation of physicians and scientists from within its region, as well as from across Pennsylvania and the nation. GCSOM in September 2020 announced a major modification to its leadership structure. Since the transformation of GCSOM, it has been the goal to integrate the school fully into Geisinger. To advance this integration, the eight clinical institutes of Geisinger were adopted as for GCSOM's clinical organizing model, with a status like the academic departments found in most medical schools.

Geisinger's Diagnostic Medicine Institute is comprised of Radiology and Geisinger Medical Laboratories. Geisinger's state-of-the-art radiology technology enables its specialists to safely and accurately perform imaging tests to develop the best treatment plan for patients. In 2020, Geisinger inked a 10-year technology agreement with Siemens Healthineers to access diagnostic imaging equipment and artificial intelligence applications. The medical technology company will provide Geisinger access to its latest digital health innovations, diagnostic imaging equipment and on-site staff to support improvements.

Geisinger seeks a nationally recognized physician scholar and leader in Radiology, one with a distinguished record of achievement in education, clinical and research work, and administration. A national search is underway to recruit an individual who will champion the Geisinger's educational programs. The Vice Chair for Education and Residency Program Director (combined position) will oversee and execute managerial responsibility for the Radiology Department's diverse educational programs.

Reporting to the System Chair for the Department of Radiology, Aalpen Patel, MD, MBA, the successful candidate will have a collaborative, team-based leadership style, and the ability to build relationships and lead through influence. They must also be operationally savvy, with the business acumen and cultural intelligence to lead within a complex, matrixed environment.
