This individual will work in tandem with operations and nursing officers for the management of the administrative, financial, and clinical performance of the cath labs and surgery program within the Cardiovascular Clinical Program at Intermountain.

Working with key organizational leaders of Intermountain, the Senior Medical Director will align and lead the Cardiovascular Clinical Program in strategic performance and improvement initiatives to ensure the measured outcomes of the program meet the highest standards. The individual must be a respected leader who is operationally savvy, highly knowledgeable in leading a matrixed clinical enterprise, and a visionary leader who can engage diverse stakeholders and work collaboratively with all disciplines.
