Cone Health, a not-for-profit health care network, serving people in Alamance, Forsyth, Guilford, Randolph, Rockingham, and surrounding counties in North Carolina, is one of the region's largest and most comprehensive health networks, with more than 150 locations, including [five hospitals](#), six ambulatory care centers, three outpatient surgery centers, [eight urgent care centers](#), two [retirement communities](#), and more than [120 physician practices](#). These include primary and specialty care through [Cone Health Medical Group](#) and [Triad HealthCare Network](#). With more than 13,000 employees, 1,800 physician partners, and 1,000 volunteers, Cone Health is actively [engaged in the communities](#) in which they serve with a commitment to their mission of providing exceptional care.

Within the Cone Health network are 6 campuses and over 500 specialists dedicated specifically to comprehensive cancer care, and Cone Health is proud to hold Quality Oncology Practice Initiative (QOPI®) Certification from the American Society of Clinical Oncology, which further validates the quality of cancer care they provide to their patients. Oncology Services has grown and flourished over the years and currently, the service line sees approximately 11,000 new patients and 5,000 analytic cases each year. As Cone Health's cancer care footprint continues to expand, the need for a Chief of Oncology Services to build upon the strong reputation of Cone Health's well-established oncology service line and cancer care locations is imperative. Reporting to the Vice President of Oncology Services, the Chief of Oncology Services will provide clinical oversight and direction to promote quality of care and appropriate resource utilization for all oncology services. They will be responsible for building a strong dyad relationship with the Vice President of Oncology Services and will work collaboratively to produce a high-performing oncology service line that delivers exceptional quality of care.

In partnership with medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, gynecologic oncologists, neuro-oncologists, medical directors of subspecialty oncology programs, and advanced practice providers, the Chief is responsible for the safety, reliability, system integration, and equitable clinical impact of inpatient and outpatient cancer care across Cone Health, and will lead the growth and expansion of oncology services in partnership with the Vice President of Oncology Services and Executive Leadership. Further, the Chief of Oncology Services will be a critical steward for an organizational climate and culture which supports and values diversity, equity, inclusion, and belonging, and who is committed to delivering hands-on, personalized cancer care that reflects the system values of Cone Health. The ideal candidate will have earned an MD, MD/PhD or DO, be board certified in one or more oncology specialties and/or sub-specialties and be eligible for licensure in the state of North Carolina. An MBA, MHA, MS, or other relevant advanced degree is additive, but not required.
