In addition, they will work closely with other clinical and basic science department chiefs within the College of Physicians and Surgeons to advance the mission of the school. They will also have the opportunity to recruit new members to the ACTA faculty and fellowship and foster a scholarly environment. The department commitment to scholarly activity is reflected in extensive programs in clinical and basic research, an accredited ACTA fellowship, and protected research time for qualified individuals.
