Campus Dean (0.6 FTE)

- Ensure comparability in the education program for teaching, assessment and education outcomes.
- Ensure campus compliance with all relevant education standards, policies and academic standards of the medical school and university.
- Ensure effective collaboration and communication between the regional and parent campus.
- Provide leadership for development of faculty for teaching, assessment and professional growth.
- Report directly to the MUSC College of Medicine Dean.
- Serve on key education program committees in the medical school pertinent to the clinical campus operation.
- Represent and promote the regional campus to medical school applicants.

Designated Institutional Officer (DIO)/Director of Medical Education (DME) (0.2 FTE)

- Serve as DIO over a highly successful solo Family Medicine Residency of 33 residents and 2 Sports Medicine fellows
- As Director of Medical Education, oversees all medical trainees on the campus as well as management of the CME programs and accreditation process.
- Serve as senior educational leader for AnMed Health, directly reporting to the Chief Medical Officer and serving on the Medical Executive Committee.

Clinical responsibilities would be assigned up to 0.2 FTE.

Qualifications: The applicant should be a board-certified physician with a minimum of the following: 7 years of experience in clinical practice, 5 years of experience in undergraduate medical student education, and 5 years of experience in graduate medical education.
